



## Painting in Provence with Instructor Pattee Hipschen

Why did so many famous painters gravitate towards the South of France? Come with us to witness the magical light and colors of Provence and you will instantly understand. Join us for this small group experience, "Painting in Provence" with popular Art League and Art's Club of Washington instructor Pattee Hipschen.



Pattee is a landscape instructor who will teach you how to master color, composition and technique. With on-site demonstrations, she helps you learn or improve your "plein air" painting. Student size is limited to 10 participants allowing lots of individualized attention and encouragement.

Offsite excursions include Pont Julien, the ancient Roman Bridge, the picturesque stone villages of Lacoste and Bonnieux, Provençal markets, the beloved village of Roussillon, home to the famous ochre mines which color the local buildings.

You will be picked up from the airport and driven to your home for the week, a beautiful centuries old estate with incredible views in all directions. Tasty, healthy meals are prepared in-house with local ingredients. Our meals together are important times to share with fellow artists. Our tour host, Josie, has been organizing tours to this area for the last 17 years and is dedicated to making your time in Provence a lasting experience, taking care of all the details so that you can focus on your art.

As a bonus, we provide most of the essential art supplies, including paint (11+ colors), easels, palettes, stools, and prepared paper. You need only pack your own brushes, and any other supplies you might be accustomed to.



The cost of the tour is \$3500 per person (based on double occupancy) and includes 8 nights lodging in a private villa, (based on double occupancy), breakfast daily, plus one complete meal a day. This price also includes all ground transportation\* including airport and train station transfers, sightseeing fees and daily art instruction. Pickup points are Marseille airport and Avignon train station. \*International airfare is NOT included.
